

CORRELATION SHEET

The Correlation Sheet illustrates the synergistic, natural relationship between the Change Cycle and the traditional, King Wen order of the 64 hexagrams. The Wilhelm-Baynes edition refers to seasons in twelve "principle" hexagrams. The Correlation Sheet text explains:

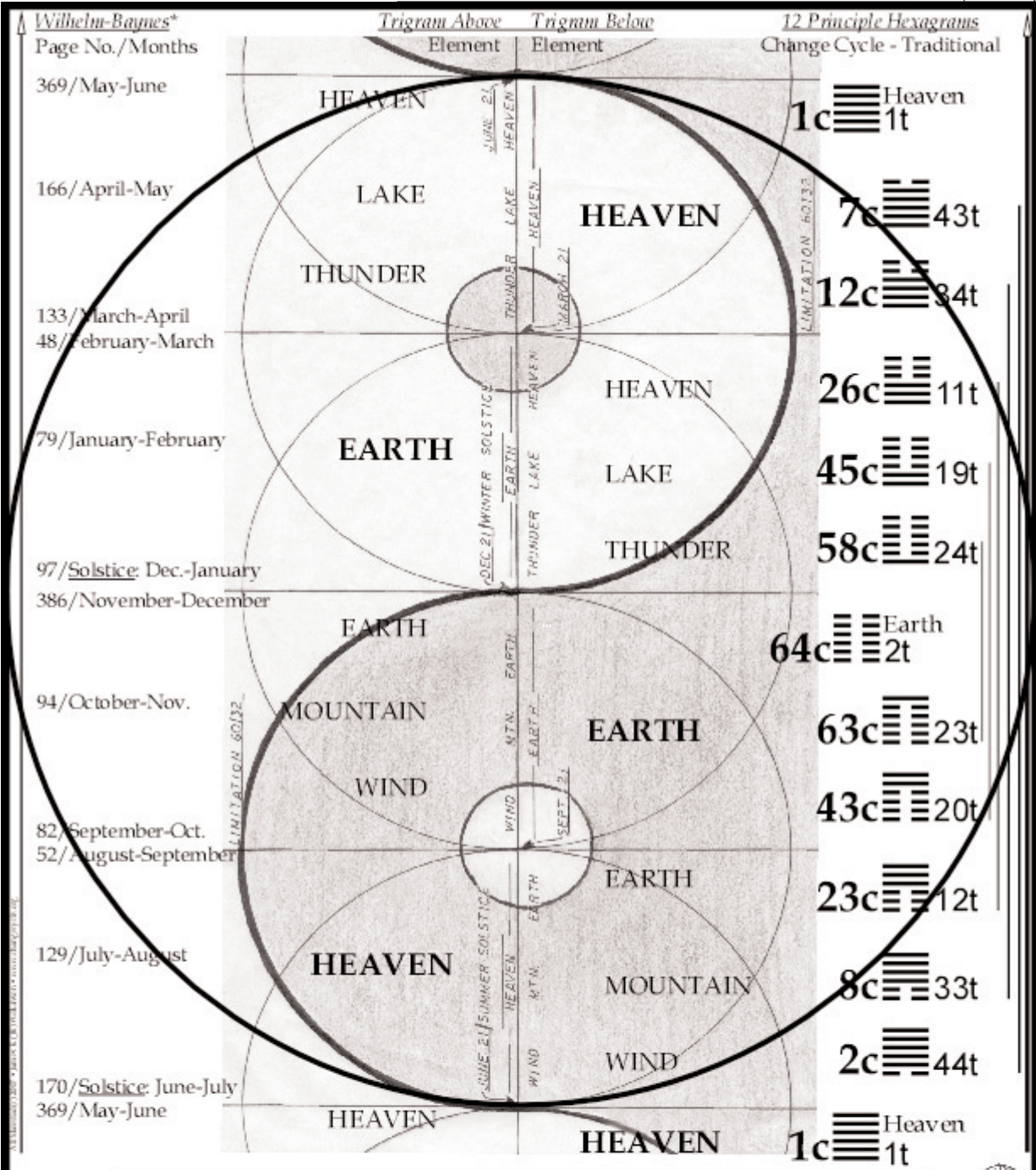
Start in the upper left corner column heading. The column lists page numbers for the twelve principle hexagrams along the right side. Use the page numbers and the Wilhelm-Baynes I Ching edition (Princeton University Press) to read the hexagram description as it relates to months. Find the vertical line. To the left are the Trigram Above elements and to the right are the Trigram Below elements for each principle hexagram. Notice alternating Heaven and Earth elements. The vertical line also marks summer solstice, fall equinox (Sept. 21), winter solstice, and spring equinox (March 21).*

Along the right, Change Cycle numbers are to the left of hexagrams and traditional numbers are to the right. Starting at the bottom with Heaven 1c/1t, the Change Cycle numbers are sequential; and starting center at Earth 64c/2t (also Heaven), the traditional hexagram numbers are paired (see far right vertical lines). The Change Cycle correlates to the traditional hexagram arrangement. Align to the awesome rhythm of time to harmonize self with environment.

CORRELATION SHEET *Heaven to Earth, I Ching*

Start in the upper left corner column heading. The column lists page numbers for the twelve principle hexagrams along the right side. Use the page numbers and the Wilhelm-Baynes *I Ching* edition* (Princeton University Press) to read the hexagram description as it relates to months. Find the vertical line. To the left are the Trigram Above elements and to the right are the Trigram Below elements for each principle hexagram. Notice alternating Heaven and Earth elements. The vertical line also marks summer solstice, fall equinox (Sept. 21), winter solstice, and spring equinox (March 21).

Along the right, Change Cycle numbers are to the left of hexagrams and traditional numbers are to the right.
